PRAYER SHAWLS - over 50 shawls have been given to those who are going through rough times due to illness or emotional concerns. We sent 2 more shawls out in March.

LIBERTY STATION DELIVERIES - Deliveries continue to be made to our Veterans. Bins are located in the Gathering Area as well as outside the Pastor's office. Any and all non-perishable foods are accepted.

HOMELESS SHELTER MEAL - At this time we will still be feeding the homeless folks at the shelter PODs until September. We still need volunteers for July and August. If you are interested in preparing a meal for up to 100 homeless guests,

please sign up at the Information Table in the Gathering Area. If you would like to donate financially towards one of those two months, make out a check to **NHRC** and **MEMO: Homeless Shelter Meal**

The latest update we have at this time is the PODs will be removed in September and the guests will be relocated to the old Dutchess County Jail until such time that the Oakley Street building is completed. Once the guests are moved into the Jail, the meal volunteers, as we were told, will no longer be needed. But, that could change at any time.

Interesting story to show the Power of God. Franca Petrillo delivered the shelter meal on Sunday afternoon. After the food was carried in to the shelter, a gentleman came out to Franca and asked if she had any clothes. She told him "as a matter of fact I do". She had a few bags of clothing in her back seat that was slated for the bin. She handed one of the bags to the gentleman and he was so grateful. Franca went to Jail for Jesus (PODs behind the jail) and ended up reaching out to someone in need. Well done Franca.

Safe Haven Pet Food Pantry: We are collecting pet food of all kinds. Safe Haven distributes needed pet food to low income families. The bin is located at the base of the stairs leading to the Pastors office.

Childrens Books: Bin is located on the Education Table. All books will be donated to FOR FAMILIES OF NEW PALTZ. It's to encourage young children to read instead of video games and computers.

Blood Drives: The blood drive on April 2nd was a big success, netting 30 units. The next blood drive is May 28th from 1pm until 6pm in Fellowship Hall
