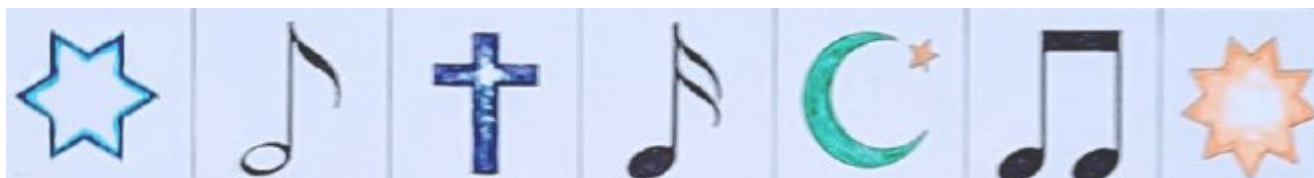
3) Lastly, love God and love people. Period. There is too much hate in the world. Be a part of the solution to choose love and kindness. IN ALL WAYS.

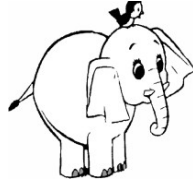
